

RESOLUTION NO. 98-13

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington has made application to the State of Nebraska Department of Roads for funding of an Adams Street grade separation project; and

WHEREAS, the State of Nebraska Department of Roads has determined that no funding priority will be established unless the City agrees to closing of the railroad grade crossings at Washington Street, Madison Street, and Adams Street; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Nebraska Department of Roads is unwilling to make a commitment to provide a pedestrian crossing to replace the closed grade crossings.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, that the Washington Street railroad grade crossing will remain closed, and the Madison Street crossings and Adams Street crossings will be permanently closed at the same time as an Adams Street viaduct is completed and open for traffic.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to enter into agreements with the Nebraska Department of Roads and with Union Pacific Railroad consistent with the terms of this Resolution.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. That the State of Nebraska Department of roads will approve funding of an Adams Street grade separation project; and
- b. The State of Nebraska Department of Roads and Union Pacific Railroad will approve and fund a pedestrian crosswalk at or in the immediate vicinity of

Madison Street as a part of the Adams Street grade separation project.
