

RESOLUTION NO. 07-07

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington, proposed to apply for assistance from the SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM for the purpose of building a hike/bike trail along the east side of North Taft Street, from approximately Third Street to Seventh Street, in order to provide a year-round safe route to Pershing Elementary School, St. Ann's Parish Center, and recreation areas Memorial Park and St. Ann's Soccer Fields, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington has available the funds to finance the activity until reimbursed by the Safe Routes to School Program, and the financial capability to operate, maintain, and manage the completed project in a safe and attractive manner for public use; and

WHEREAS, the proposed application and supporting documents were made available for public review at a properly announced meeting of the City of Lexington;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, that the City of Lexington applies for assistance from the Safe Routes to School Program for the purpose of funding the Pershing Elementary School Trail Project.
